










CHARTER PROGRAMS

Philadelphia Museum of Art

Our visual arts programs provide in-depth experiences including after school art clubs, artists-in-residence programs, and an immersive summer filmmaking intensive.

Students have access to the museum's world-renowned collection through customized gallery tours. They create artwork inspired by the collection using high quality materials and learn a variety of artistic techniques.

Classes are taught by professional teaching artists and the museum's award-winning education staff. Student art exhibitions are displayed and celebrated at the museum and throughout the city.

Philadelphia Ballet

Our comprehensive after school, in school and summer programs provide professional dance instruction for middle and high school level students. Students experience dance forms including classical ballet, jazz, Latin, African and contemporary dance. At the high school level, students delve into the choreographic process and create original dance pieces. The program culminates with collaborative student performances and public performances.

The program is supplemented with creative writing workshops inspired by dance, the opportunity to attend Philadelphia Ballet performances, backstage tours to learn about the many career opportunities involved in dance production, and customized tours at the Philadelphia Museum of Art.

Beyond learning technical dance skills, the programs provide a creative outlet for expression, develop collaboration skills, and build self-confidence.

Philadelphia Zoo

West Philadelphia Zoo Scholars is an award-winning college-prep and career skills building program. The program provides three years of immersion in the sciences through academic and experiential learning opportunities after school and in the summer.

Students participate in hands-on animal care, conservation initiatives, off-site eco-excursions, and college readiness workshops.

The program introduces students to, and prepares them for, careers in the zoological and animal sciences, with a particular emphasis on zoo keeping, wildlife conservation, and veterinary sciences.
